Welcome

Mixon View is a luxury self-catering barn conversion in the Peak District National Park sleeping two in one upstairs bedroom. The ground floor living area is open plan with oak flooring. There is level access from a flat car parking area right next to the front door. Single step to level patio at the rear where there are beautiful views over farmland. Mixon View is adjacent to the larger Morridge View (sleeps 10) which has a ground floor bedroom and is suitable for wheelchair users. Groups of up to 12 may have exclusive use of both properties. The location is quiet and secluded so ideal for those who need peace and quiet.

- We have non-allergic bedding.

Travel by taxi

- You can get a taxi with Leek Link by calling 01538399999. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.
- From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The route is 800mm wide, or more.

Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 800mm wide, or more.

Main entrance

- The main entrance has level access.
- The door is 800mm wide.
- The main door is side hung and manual.
- When you arrive, we can help carry your luggage.

Getting around inside

Visual Impairment - General Information

- We have high colour contrast between walls and doorframes.

Bedrooms

- The bedroom has windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, bedside lamps and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED. TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- No bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- We can move the bedroom furniture, to improve accessibility.
- The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 13 steps.
- All bedrooms are ensuite.
- We have bathrooms with a separate shower.
- The walls and the fittings have high colour contrast.
- The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the left.

Self catering kitchen

Main kitchen

- We have an open plan kitchen.
- From the main entrance to the kitchen, there is level access.
- The route is 800mm wide, or more.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.

Lounge

Main lounge

- From the main entrance to the lounge, there is level access. The route is 800mm wide, or more.

Getting around outside

Patio

- From the main entrance to the area, there is 1 step.
